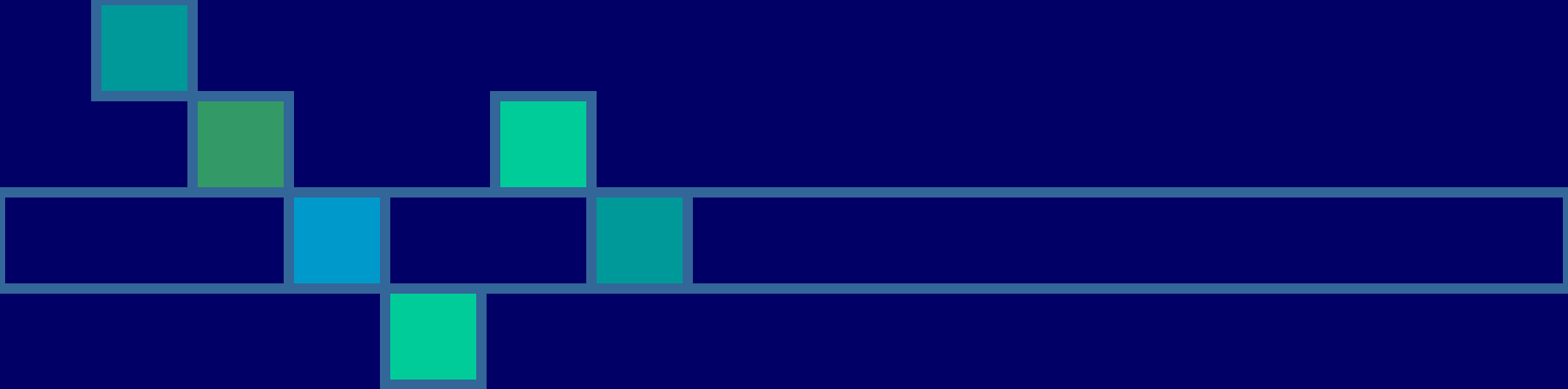

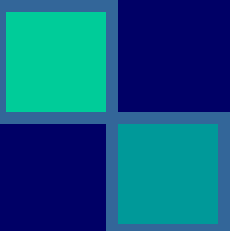

NSABB Working Group: Oversight of Research with Dual Use Potential



 - **Consultations with stakeholders**
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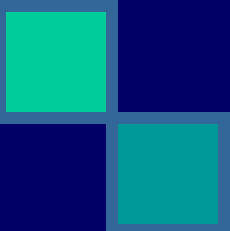



Oversight of Dual Use Research: Major Issues to be Addressed

 - Review of issues by USG and/or NSABB
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


Honing in on Issues

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- Purpose(s) of each activity
 - Process: how should it be carried out and by whom?
 - Roles and responsibilities
 - Necessary attributes and expertise of individuals/entity involved in activity
 - Possible candidates

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- **Timing**
 - **When should activity be carried out?**
 - **Is ongoing activity necessary?**
 - **If so, by what process?**
 - **Is there need for an appeals process?**
 - **Tools**
